International Conference on *Regina Jonas: Women, Judaism and Religion*

The National Research Institute, Istituto Italiano di Studi Germanici, is organizing the International Conference on *Regina Jonas: Women, Judaism and Religion*. The conference aims to investigate the personal life, thinking, theological writings and political commitment of Regina Jonas as well as the historical context in which she lived and worked and then also the impact of her personality on contemporary theological and cultural issues.

Possible topics include also religious affiliation and gender from a more general perspective analysing both tradition and modernity: the presence and the role of women in Judaism and Christianity, the impact of Judaism in women's emancipation, stereotypes and consistency of patriarchalism in Judaism and Christianity, the changes of rabbi's and priest's figures, roles and commitment in contemporary society.

We encourage the submission of papers which adopt a multidisciplinary approach.

A selection of papers presented at the conference will be considered for publication.
